## **Get to Know Your Digital Camera**

## **Shooting Your Artwork**

This workshop teaches participants how to photograph their artwork using a digital camera and to prepare the images for juried shows. It covers the basic concepts and terminology, camera features, and how to light and photograph a variety of artwork, including sculpture, fabric, and jewelry. You also learn how to process the digital images and properly format them for show entries and a variety of other uses. In addition, you will receive a booklet with material from the workshop. Participants should have access to a digital camera and some basic computer knowledge. *The workshop is limited to a maximum of 15 participants.*
